The JFC Brunssum Tri-Border Walking Club, established in 1977, is one of several clubs that come under the umbrella of the Family Support, Morale and Welfare Branch of the Base Support Group at HQ JFCBS. The club is open to NATO personnel and their families affiliated with the military bases in the tri-border area. We offer recreational walks devised by our own Walks Coordination Member as well as ones organised by local “wandeltocht/volksmarch” groups. Walks take place in The Netherlands, Germany and Belgium.

Our primary objective is to get together, internationally, in a spirit of camaraderie to promote health and recreation.

Walks are monthly. Average distance options range through 7, 12 and 18 km, hopefully catering for most abilities. Routes can be through urban, rural or wooded areas but many are a combination of all three and often have a refreshment opportunity along the way. Virtually all routes are scenic and there is no better way to see and experience the local countryside.

Walks are not led so you can progress at your own pace. A Club committee member will always be present at the beginning of an event to provide directions (usually in the form of a basic map that gives an overview of the route options) and to get you started. Thereafter you are free to make your own way or join/form an informal group with other members, usually based on choice of distance. Given the walks are unsupervised, it is advisable to have the means (perhaps a smartphone GPS App) to find your way back to the start point, should you get lost!

Walk coordination is managed via a closed Facebook Group. The Club has a mobile phone which is operational on the day of a walk for contact with the organiser.
