



WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DE-REGISTER YOUR VEHICLE?

Please make sure to provide us with:

- Your NATO ID card.
- The current JFC Brunssum 'Certificate of Title and Registration'.
- The Customs Declaration/Verklaring (previously owned/tax paid vehicles bought from the Dutch market do not apply).
- The yellow license plate(s).

In order to be able to export your vehicle outside of The Netherlands, you will need to either:

- Get your white export license plates at the plate shop in Landgraaf, or;
- If you have a valid registration in the country of origin, and still got the plates, you can use those.

EXEMPTIONS:

There are 3 exemptions to this rule, where the yellow license plates are allowed to remain on the vehicle:

- Vehicles that are going to Türkiye via Serbia.
- Vehicles that will be registered at NATO Air Base Geilenkirchen (yellow plates need to be turned in afterwards).
- Vehicles that are shipped to USA or Canada via USAG (Garrison Base Brunssum).

In case the vehicle is being scrapped, we need:

- Your NATO ID card
- The current JFC Brunssum 'Certificate of Title and Registration'
- The Customs Declaration/Verklaring (previously owned vehicles bought from the Dutch market do not apply).
- The scrap report
- The yellow license plate(s). Please **DO NOT** let the scrap company keep the yellow plates. They are NATO plates, and should be turned in to Vehicle Registration Office!
